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Overview

The Issues

Default on Debt and Loss of Fundraising Status

Because the accounting software was not updated on a regular basis, accurate reports could not be generated without manually manipulating them after an export.

Duplication of work led to inaccurate record keeping. For example, payroll data was manually entered into a spreadsheet and then again manually entered into the accounting software. Paper invoices were circulated around the organization and stored in file cabinets, and vendor invoices lacked approval documentation. Additionally, the staff manually keyed invoices, bill payments, and deposits into the accounting software.

Due to inefficiencies in the accounting systems and inaccurate record keeping, the organization could not complete their audit on time nor file a tax return timely.

The late financial reporting caused them to default on their debt, and the late filing of the Form 990 resulted in a loss of their fundraising status.

Along with the default and the loss of fundraising status, the lack of transparency in financial reporting put the organization at greater risk of fraudulent activity going undetected.
